The certificate of declaration shall contain the date of blood testing, name and address of the owner or exhibitor, also the number, breed, species and identification band number of each bird to be exhibited. Poultry must be accompanied by results of a negative pullorum typhoid test conducted within 90 days prior to exhibition OR proof that the birds originated directly from a U.S. pullorum typhoid clean flock or equivalent flock.

- Entries will be limited according to coop space.
- Exhibitors are to send copies of health paper(s) with entries.
- All pullets and cockerels must have been hatched in the current year.
- The Gouverneur and St. Lawrence County Fair reserves the right to reject any and all entries.
- All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor 30 days before the opening of the fair.
- Only birds listed in the Fair's Breed Classification Chart will be accepted. Code numbers must be listed for each variety. No more than 20 birds per person.
- Any bird deemed out of condition at the time of cooping will not be accepted.
- Awards will be placed on coops for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners.
- Use official Gouverneur and St. Lawrence County Fair entry blanks only.
- Coop tags will be on the cages ready for your birds on Monday, August 3rd.
- The Gouverneur and St. Lawrence County Fair will use every precaution against accident or loss but will not be responsible should a loss occur.
- The Poultry superintendent and judges will have final jurisdiction and reserve the right to coop birds as they see fit.
- The judges will be qualified poultry judges.
- Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry.
- No advertising will be allowed on coops until after judging.
- Birds will be fed and watered, and eggs will be gathered by THE SUPERINTENDENT AND STAFF ONLY!!!
- Birds will only be handled by the judges and superintendent.
- Premiums will be paid on the awards indicated by the judge's records.
- All rules are to be interpreted by the fair through its poultry superintendent.
